



COOKS ENDEAVOUR RETURNS WITH TREASURE

While illustrating a scene from 'Stowaway', our garden highlights botanical discoveries that were typical of Captain Cook's voyages as well as others of that era. View a scene where Joseph Banks and company landed on a plant hunting expedition and see the wonders of this new land. A bubbling spring in a shady grotto provides the landing party with a vital commodity for sea voyages – water. Recent horticultural finds are drying in the sun while waiting to be documented in journals, then packed for the journey home. Supplies are stored under a shelter made from local materials. Bold leaves and colors capture attention on the sunny side. Look closely to discover fauna 'living' near the spring, the beach or rocky outcrop. While inspired by historic voyages, the garden includes plant material from many different continents, climate zones and topographies. The garden demonstrates the design principles of correct placement for microclimates.
